<p>Judaism</p> <p><i>proper noun</i></p>	<p>the religion of the Hebrews; it is the world's oldest monotheistic religion</p>
<p>Abraham</p> <p><i>proper noun</i></p>	<p>an early Hebrew who left Mesopotamia and settled with his family in Canaan; his descendants, the Hebrews, lived in Canaan for many years</p>
<p>Moses</p> <p><i>proper noun</i></p>	<p>freed the Hebrew slaves in Egypt and led his people out of Egypt</p>
<p>Exodus</p> <p><i>proper noun</i></p>	<p>the journey of the Hebrews, led by Moses, from Egypt to Canaan after they were freed from slavery</p>

**Ten
Commandments**

proper noun

in the Bible, a code of moral laws given to Moses by God

David

proper noun

a king of Israel who defeated the Philistines and captured lands including the city of Jerusalem

Solomon

proper noun

the son of David who took the throne in 965 BC; he built a great temple to God in Jerusalem

Diaspora

proper noun

the scattering of the Jews outside of Canaan after the Babylonian captivity
